T2 Oak: crown reduce

The tree is a mature oak forming part of the group of tall trees which are a valued feature of the attractive street scene of Glade Close. It is suggested that while there is no objection in principle to the proposal, the work should be limited to that necessary for the health of the tree and safety of residents.

#### 3.3 [T/00346/17/TPO](#) 40 Minden Close

T1 Field maple: crown lift and crown raise

The tree has an attractive well shaped crown and is a feature the sylvan landscape of Minden Close. The main impact on the street scene is the appearance of the crown above the house roof. While there is no objection in principle to the works as requested, it is suggested that the tree officer consult with the applicant to ensure that the crown reductions are limited to those necessary to maintain the trees and their impact on the amenity of Minden Close.
