

September 2018 RRW monthly summary

- Trolleys: 4 (11) (reported to Trolleywise/1 trolley reported direct to The Range).
- Litter: some paper wrappers and cans along Thornhill Way & Hanmore Road.
- Vandalism: spray painting in various areas - crossing to Tesco from Binfields Woods, the board awaiting a new notice and cover & the fence close by, obscene graffiti on Cufaude Lane walking from Thornhill Way north on the cycle path, approx. 100m from the road (reported to BDBC & Community Safety Patrol Officer).
- Dog-fouling: there are plenty of bags and notices on the footpath leading from St. Leonards Avenue towards Warbleton Road.
- Footpath: the areas around Simon's Road and Upper Stroud Close are looking much better after the undergrowth has been cut back. The footpath/cycle path close to the A33 traffic lights where it has been traversed, the tarmac has sunk by approximately 2.5 inches (reported to HCC).
- Steps: the steps are damaged on the footpath leading from Thornhill Way to Petty's Copse (between Belvedere Gardens & Fennel Close) (reported to HCC).
- Crossing outside Village Hall: belisha beacon not working on left hand side as you enter Chineham (reported to HCC).
- Overgrowth: BDBC has been out and about grass cutting and hedge cutting so things are looking much better around the parish.
- Resurfacing: the area between Tollway and the roundabout still has many areas marked up.
- Noticeboards: these have been updated as requested.
