main boughs have been previously pollarded and there is no objection to the proposed reduction to these points.

Chineham Parish Council objects strongly to this application. The proposed development would adversely impact Chineham's already overburdened infrastructure and local amenities, i.e. schools and medical facilities whilst adding even more traffic onto the A33 which at peak times already operates at very full capacity. Additionally, the proposed access directly onto the A33 would be extremely difficult to navigate safely and would undoubtedly lead to accidents as drivers take more risks because of heavy traffic flow.
