#### 3. To review and provide feedback on the following new applications:

#### 3.1 23/02266/LDPO 63 Fennel Close Chineham, RG24 8XF

Certificate of lawfulness for the proposed loft conversion including installation of 1 No crown roof dormer to the rear elevation & 3 No roof-lights to the front elevation, to form additional habitable space.

Chineham Parish Council has no objection to this application.

## 3.2 23/02137/HSE 7 Lovegroves Chineham, RG24 8YA

Single storey side and rear extension.

Chineham Parish Council has no objection to this application but would like to make the following comments:

- It is noted that the roof pitch is 12degrees, the Planning Committee feel a Planning Officer should consider a condition for appropriate roof material to be used.
- -The Planning Committee expresses concerns with the south west guttering, it is shown as being in close proximity to the property boundary.

# 3.4 23/01133/FUL Land At Redlands Phase 3 Reading Road Sherfield-on-Loddon Hampshire

Erection of 30 dwellings including affordable homes, demolition of Redlands House and associated buildings, vehicular access off the approved Phase 1 development, pedestrian links to Phases 1 and 2, open space, SuDS, underground foul pumping station, and associated landscaping including minor earthworks for drainage infrastructure (to be known as Phase 3).

- The proposed reduction seems excessive, any reduction that is carried out should be in accordance with the Basingstoke & Deane Borough Council Tree Officer.
