Conversion of loft to living accommodation including dormer windows and rooflights to rear elevation, two storey front extension with new higher roof to front elevation with rooflights. Erection of single storey rear extension and front porch roof

Councillors David Thornton and Marian Adams having declared an interest in this application did not comment or take part in agreeing the Planning Committee's feedback.

Chineham Parish Council has no objection to this application although there are concerns about privacy issues for neighbours at the rear of the property and we request a planning condition that any new windows overlooking neighbouring properties are of obscured glass.
